In July 2012, Augean was granted a Development Consent Order to construct new facilities to recover and dispose of hazardous and low level radioactive wastes at the ENRMF.

The consent includes the construction of new landfill void in the area to the west of the currently worked part of the site. The new void space will be constructed in a series of phases which will be progressively restored to an ecological end use.

Before any construction of the new void space takes place Augean is required to obtain variations to the conditions of its Environmental Permits for hazardous waste and radioactive wastes. All Waste management facilities require a valid Environmental Permit and different site activities require different permits.

The aim of the Environmental Permitting regime is to provide a framework to ensure that site operations satisfy all legal policy and regulatory requirements so that people and the environment are properly protected. Typically Environmental Permits establish acceptable limits for emissions to land, air and water. Permits additionally set rigorous criteria for a site monitoring regime, compliant environmental management systems, technical competency of staff, landfill design and aftercare provision post closure of the site amongst other matters.

Any Environment Permit application is accompanied by a number of risk assessments that have been undertaken to demonstrate to the Environment Agency and its consultees that Augean is able to operate the site in compliance with all International, European and national health and safety standards without significant impacts to human health or the environment and will continue to do so in the future.

The application for the variation of the hazardous wastes Environmental Permit was accepted and consulted on by the Environment Agency earlier this year, and is anticipated to be issued within the next few weeks.

The application for the variation of the radioactive wastes Environmental Permit was submitted to the Environment Agency in late July.

At the Open Day, Augean would like to give the local community the opportunity to discuss the radioactive wastes permit with the technical team involved in its preparation and other members of staff to directly address any concerns that may be felt.

An exhibition giving background to the permit applications will be available as well as the usual site tours and laboratory tours.

The Environment Agency will also be present and available to discuss the permit application.
